Often the concept of 'grief' is only associated with death. However, grief can occur following any loss. Losses such as leaving things familiar when moving town; children leaving home, not being able to drive or live alone anymore; being made redundant or a relationship ending, the death of a pet, being advised of a terminal illness and the loss of body function name but a few of the losses and changes that people may be faced with throughout their lives. Whether it is circumstances such as these, or the loss of a loved one, our service is available to everyone in our community.

At Grief Support Services our counsellors offer one on one and whanau/family sessions to help those in need talk about their experience of loss and grief in a supportive and caring way and help them make sense of the change that is taking place in their life.
